



Pipeline Project Has Kicked Off



Approximately 7,000 feet of the pipeline will be replaced from the old Sebastian building to Thomas Street. Thanks to the \$700 thousand dollar water transfer and a PCWA grant, no new or additional debt will be necessary to complete this project. This section of the pipeline dates to the 1950s and has reached the end of its service life. By replacing it, Foresthill will have improved fire protection.
