Reservoir Updates

Reservoir currently 85% full



Operators perform weekly checks at the Sugar Pine Reservoir. Part of the inspection is to calculate the inflow, process the elevation of the reservoir, adjust the fish flow if needed, and any other items that may arise while they are up there.



Check irrigation systems.

Fully drain the system and make sure everything is turned off.

Turn up the thermostat.

Keep your house warm even when you aren't home.

Check for freezing points.

Areas around the home that are prone to freezing: crawl spaces, unheated rooms, garages, and exterior walls.

Air sealing plumbing and piping.

Sealing around all exterior pipe openings to prevent cold airflow.

Protect your pipes.

Wrapping exposed pipes with insulation or heat tape will protect them in harsh temperatures.
