I, FRANK M. JORDAN, Secretary of State of the State of California, hereby certify:

That on the 3rd day of August, 1950, pursuant to the provisions of Section 9 of the "Public Utility District Act" approved May 31, 1921, as amended (Act 6391 of Deering's General Laws), there was filed in my office a Roll, consisting of a Certificate of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer, under the seal of said Board, together with a copy of the Order adopted by said Board on the 31st day of July, 1950, certified by the Clerk thereof.

I further certify that July 25, 1950, is stated in said Certificate as the date of the election held in certain territory of said County at which there was submitted to the electors thereof the following proposition:

"Shall the Foresthill Public Utility District be organized under the provisions of the Public Utility District Act, approved May 31, 1921, and the amendments thereto?"

and that it is shown in the said Certificate that the total vote cast at said election was 219 and that 214 votes were cast in favor of the organization of such district and five (5) votes were cast against the organization thereof.

I further certify that the aforesaid Order of the Board of Supervisors declared approval of the foregoing proposition, stated the name and boundaries of the district as in said act provided and declared formation of the district under the provisions of said act.

In 1953 the District took over the water system from the Finning Family. The Foresthill Public Utility District was formed in 1950 and purchased the Forest Hills Water Works in 1953. Be happy about where you live, embrace the beautiful Foresthill community, and appreciate the local resources we have right in our backyard.
