#### Term of Office

The selected individual will fill the unexpired term through 2018.

#### Minimum Requirements

- Must be United States Citizen and Registered Voter in Placer County
- Must be 18 years of age or older and living within the FPUD Service Area

#### Examples of Director Duties:

- In accordance with the Brown Act, attend Board meetings; actively participate in decision and policy-making processes. Work collaboratively as a member of the Board to determine policy and provide direction on District services and programs.
- Prepare for Board meetings by becoming familiar with the agenda and supporting materials.
- Review and participate in adopting the District's annual budget; making water rate adjustments and sound financial decisions.
- Hire and evaluate performance of District's General Manager, Legal Counsel, Auditor and Engineer.
- Represent the District on committees: internal, external and ad hoc committees.
- Represent the District at public functions, ceremonial and related events.
- File a California Fair Political Practices Commission Statement of Economic Interests form

## Information about the District

The Foresthill Public Utility District (FPUD) operates the public utility water system for the unincorporated community of Foresthill, California, located in Placer County, approximately 60 miles northeast of Sacramento. The Foresthill area is located on the ridge between the North and Middle Forks of the American River, commonly referred to as the Foresthill Divide.

The FPUD incorporates an area of approximately 13,000 acres and contains primarily residential development. Foresthill has a population of approximately 6,000 and the District provides approximately 2,000 water service connections.

### The District's Board of Directors

The District is governed by a five-member Board of Directors and currently employs eight full-time employees.

Directors are elected to four year terms by registered voters in the District. Directors must reside within the District service area.

### FPUD Board Meetings

The FPUD Board meets in regular session on the second Wednesday of each month at 2:00 p.m. at the Veteran's Memorial Hall, Foresthill, CA 95631, with special meetings of the Board scheduled as needed.

The District was formed in 1950 pursuant to the provisions of Section 15501 et seq. of the California Public Utilities Code for the purpose of operating a public utility water system. The District's water system supplies drinking and irrigation water to about 1,900 customers.
